Jesus of Nazareth Convicted

The notorious blasphemer and rebel, Jesus of Nazareth, was arrested last night on the Mount of Olives. His followers scattered and were not apprehended

Jesus was tried this morning by the Sanhedrin and found to be guilty of the serious crime of blasphemy. He had also been charged with lesser crimes, having threatened to destroy the Temple and overturned the tables of tradesmen in the Court of the Gentiles, but these were not considered at his trial.

The death sentence was passed on Jesus, but cannot be executed by the Temple authorities in Jerusalem. He has therefore been handed over to the Roman governor for sentence to be confirmed and carried out.
